In 1999, FSC Architects and Engineers were selected to provide comprehensive architectural and engineering design services for the City of Dawson’s new Swimming Pool Facility.

The new facility provides seasonal aquatic programs to residents and visitors alike from late April to September. The stainless steel and liner pool tank is uniquely configured to include four 25-meter lanes and a beach entry. The shape of the tank is complemented by a six-person hot tub in close proximity to the shallow portion of the main tank.

To enhance the overall aquatic experience both ends of the Pool feature large expanses of glass to let the light of the long summer days in. In keeping with the mining theme of Dawson the main roof structure is exposed in the Hall; large Glulam trusses provide a feeling of spaciousness.

Support spaces include a viewing area in the Pool; male and female change rooms and a staff office adjacent to the main entry.
